Meaning: Surmise: to form an opinion or make an inference about something without complete evidence or proof.

1. She could only surmise the reasons behind his sudden departure.
2. Based on his recent behavior, I can only surmise that he is feeling overwhelmed.
3. The detective had to surmise the motive from the few clues left at the scene.
4. After reviewing the evidence, they began to surmise that the incident was not an accident.
