

SURPLICE

Meaning: Surplice: a loose-fitting, white or colored garment worn over a cassock by clergy or choir members during religious services.

1. The priest donned his white surplice over the cassock for the Sunday service.
2. In the choir, each member wore a colorful surplice that added vibrancy to the sacred music.
3. Traditionally, a surplice is worn during liturgical ceremonies to signify purity and holiness.
4. As she walked down the aisle, the bride's attendants wore elegant surplices that complemented her gown.
5. The surplice swayed gently as the minister moved gracefully during the procession.
