Meaning: Surrebut (verb): To present a reply or counterargument in response to a rebuttal made by an opposing party, typically in legal or debate contexts.

1. The attorney prepared to surrebut the opposing counsel's claims during the trial.
2. In the debate, she was ready to surrebut any arguments that challenged her position.
3. After hearing the initial rebuttal, he gathered his thoughts to surrebut effectively.
4. The scholar aimed to surrebut the criticisms of her research in the next publication.
5. During the discussion, he confidently surrebutted the misconceptions presented by his peers.
