Meaning: To temporarily halt or pause an activity or process.

2. After careful consideration, the board voted to suspend the project temporarily.

4. The artist chose to suspend her work on the sculpture to focus on other priorities.

8. The company chose to suspend the project until further funding could be secured.
9. After a thorough investigation, the athlete was suspended from competition for a year.
10. To create a sense of anticipation, the author chose to suspend the reveal of the main character's identity until the final chapter.
