

# SUZERAINTY

*Meaning: Suzerainty refers to a relationship in which a dominant state exercises control over a vassal state, allowing it limited autonomy in exchange for protection and allegiance.*

1. The concept of suzerainty often surfaces in discussions of historical empires and their control over vassal states.
2. In the treaty, the smaller nation acknowledged the suzerainty of the dominant power, agreeing to its terms for protection.
3. The decline of suzerainty in the region marked a significant shift towards greater independence for the smaller states.

5. Scholars debate whether suzerainty should be viewed as a cooperative relationship or a form of domination.

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
