

SWEAR

Meaning: To affirm or promise solemnly, often invoking a deity or using an oath, especially in a legal or formal context.

1. I swear I left my keys on the kitchen counter.
2. She raised her hand and swore to tell the truth in court.
3. After the game, he swore he would never play with that team again.
4. Do you really swear that you won't say anything to anyone?
5. I can't believe you would swear at your own brother like that.
6. I swear I saw her at the café yesterday.
7. He swore to tell the truth during his testimony.
8. After losing the game, he swore he would practice harder.
9. They exchanged oaths and swore allegiance to each other.
10. She swears by that brand of coffee for its exceptional flavor.
