

SWEEPAGE

Meaning: Seepage refers to the slow escape or leakage of liquid, such as water, through porous materials or surfaces.

1. The construction team was concerned about the seepage of water from the foundation.
2. After the heavy rain, there was noticeable seepage in the basement, prompting an urgent inspection.
3. Seepage from the aging pipes has led to significant damage in the surrounding areas.
