

SYMPLOCE

Meaning: Symploce is a rhetorical device that involves the repetition of a word or phrase at the beginning of successive clauses (anaphora) and at the end of those clauses (epistrophe) to create emphasis.

1. Symploce is a rhetorical device that combines anaphora and epistrophe for emphasis.
2. In his speech, the politician employed symploce to reinforce his commitment to justice and equality.
3. The poet's use of symploce created a powerful rhythm that captivated the audience.
4. By repeating the phrase at both the beginning and the end of the clause, the author skillfully utilized symploce.
5. In literature, symploce often highlights contrasting ideas, making the message more poignant and memorable.
