

SYNCHONDROSIS

Meaning: Synchondrosis is a type of cartilaginous joint in which two bones are connected by hyaline cartilage, often allowing for growth and flexibility.

2. The growth plates in children's long bones function as synchondroses, allowing for lengthening as they grow.

5. Orthopedic surgeons often evaluate synchondroses when diagnosing conditions related to joint development and stability.

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
