*Meaning: Syncopate: to emphasize a weak beat or offbeat in music, creating a rhythmic complexity that enhances the overall dynamic feel.*

1. The drummer decided to syncopate the rhythm to give the song a more dynamic feel.
2. In jazz music, musicians often syncopate their melodies to create unexpected and exciting moments.
3. To enhance the dance track, the producer chose to syncopate the bass line for added groove.
