

SYNECDOCHICAL

Meaning: Synecdochical refers to a figure of speech in which a part is used to represent the whole or vice versa.

1. The use of the term "wheels" to refer to a car is a classic example of a synecdochical expression.
2. In literature, the author's use of synecdochical phrases often adds depth to the narrative.
3. When discussing the team, calling them "the hands" is a synecdochical way to emphasize their hard work.
4. Her speech included several synecdochical references that illustrated the larger cultural implications of her argument.
5. The artist employed a synecdochical technique, portraying just the eyes to convey a wide range of emotions.
