

SYNECDOCHICALLY

Meaning: Synecdochically: in a manner that uses a part to represent the whole or a specific example to illustrate a broader concept.

1. She used the term synecdochically to refer to the whole community by mentioning just the leaders.
2. In his speech, he synecdochically represented the nation's struggles through a single family's story.
3. The author wrote synecdochically, using the city to symbolize the larger societal issues at play.
4. When discussing the team, he synecdochically referred to the players as "the heart and soul" of the organization.
5. Her painting was synecdochically rich, depicting a single flower to evoke the beauty of an entire garden.
