

TACET

Meaning: TACET: a directive in music indicating that a performer or group should remain silent for a specified duration.

1. The conductor signaled for the musicians to remain tacet during the solo performance.
2. In the score, the composer indicated a tacet section to create a dramatic pause.
3. During the rehearsal, the choir had to be tacet while the soloist took the spotlight.
4. The pianist chose to play the piece with a tacet interlude, enhancing the overall atmosphere.
5. Understanding the term tacet was essential for the orchestra members to follow the arrangement.
