

TARSECTOMY

Meaning: Tarsectomy is a surgical procedure involving the removal of one or more tarsal bones in the foot to alleviate pain or correct deformities.

1. A tarsectomy may be necessary to relieve chronic pain in patients with severe foot deformities.
2. The surgeon explained that a tarsectomy could improve the patient's mobility and reduce discomfort.
3. After the tarsectomy, the patient was advised to follow a strict rehabilitation program to regain strength.
4. Complications following a tarsectomy are rare but can include infection and prolonged swelling.
