

TAUTOLOGIZE

Meaning: To tautologize means to repeat the same idea or statement in different words, often unnecessarily, which can weaken the clarity or impact of an argument.

1. It's easy to tautologize when trying to emphasize a point without realizing it.
2. The speaker tended to tautologize, making his arguments sound less convincing.
3. In academic writing, one must be careful not to tautologize, as it can dilute the message.
4. During the debate, she was criticized for her tendency to tautologize rather than provide new insights.
5. He often tautologizes in conversation, repeating the same idea in different words.
