Meaning: Telegraph: a system or device for transmitting messages over long distances using coded signals, typically via wire.

1. The invention of the telegraph revolutionized long-distance communication in the 19th century.

4. The telegraph operator tapped out messages rapidly, connecting people across vast distances.
