Meaning: TEMPORIZATION: The act of delaying or postponing a decision or action, often to gain time or gather additional information.

1. The concept of temporization can often lead to procrastination in decision-making.
2. In negotiations, temporization may be a strategic move to buy time and gather more information.
3. The temporization of responses during the meeting indicated a lack of confidence among the team members.
4. Her approach to temporization allowed her to explore various options before committing to a final decision.
5. Critics argued that the temporization of government policies was detrimental to urgent reforms needed in society.
