Meaning: TEMPORIZE: To delay making a decision or taking action in order to gain time or avoid conflict.

1. In an effort to appease both sides, the politician chose to temporize rather than take a firm stance.
2. The manager decided to temporize during the meeting, hoping to gather more information before making a decision.
3. Rather than confront the issue directly, she opted to temporize, which only delayed the inevitable.
4. He tends to temporize when faced with difficult choices, often leading to missed opportunities.
5. During negotiations, it's sometimes strategic to temporize until you can better assess the other party's position.
