

# TEMPORIZER

*Meaning: TEMPORIZER: a person who delays making decisions or takes a noncommittal stance to avoid conflict or please multiple parties.*

1. The politician was often criticized as a temporizer, avoiding concrete decisions to please all parties.
2. In a crisis, a temporizer can hinder progress by delaying necessary actions and relying on indecision.
3. Her tendency to be a temporizer in negotiations often frustrated her colleagues, who preferred decisive leadership.
4. As a temporizer, he believed that taking time to assess the situation would ultimately lead to better outcomes.
5. The project's success was jeopardized by the temporizer's reluctance to commit to a clear plan of action.
