

TENESMIC

Meaning: TENESMIC: relating to a painful or uncomfortable sensation of needing to pass urine or stool, often accompanied by anxiety or urgency.

1. The patient described a tenesmic sensation that left her feeling uncomfortable and anxious.
2. After eating the spicy meal, he experienced a tenesmic urge that was hard to ignore.
