

TERGIVERSATE

Meaning: To tergiversate means to be evasive or to change one's position or opinions, especially in a way that avoids commitment or clarity.

1. The politician continued to tergiversate when questioned about his stance on environmental policy.
2. Despite his initial enthusiasm, he began to tergiversate under pressure from his critics.
3. In the debate, she was accused of tergiversating on key issues, leaving the audience confused about her true beliefs.
4. His tendency to tergiversate made it difficult for his colleagues to trust his commitment to the project.
5. Rather than taking a firm position, he chose to tergiversate, hoping to avoid alienating any potential supporters.
