

TERMINATIVE

Meaning: Terminative refers to something that brings an end or conclusion, such as a clause in a contract that permits withdrawal or a linguistic aspect that signifies the completion of an action.

1. The contract included a terminative clause that allowed either party to withdraw under certain conditions.
2. In linguistics, a terminative aspect indicates the completion of an action.
3. The team's terminative goal for the project was to achieve full market launch by the end of the year.
4. She felt a sense of relief when she received the terminative announcement that her job was secure.
5. The terminative nature of the agreement meant that all responsibilities would cease after the final payment was made.
