Meaning: Thegn: a nobleman or warrior in Anglo-Saxon England who held land granted by the king in exchange for loyalty and service.

1. The thegn was rewarded with land for his loyalty to the king.

3. The thegns gathered in the great hall to discuss matters of the realm.
4. As a thegn, he was expected to provide military service in times of war.
