

THORAX

Meaning: Thorax: the part of the body between the neck and the abdomen that contains vital organs in humans and supports the attachment of legs and wings in insects.

1. The thorax is an important part of the human anatomy, housing vital organs.
2. In many insects, the thorax is where the legs and wings are attached.
