Meaning: To indicate an intention to cause harm or danger, often creating a sense of impending risk or menace.

1. The dark clouds began to threaten a fierce storm later that evening.
2. He didn't mean to threaten anyone; it was just a heated moment.
3. The rising temperatures could threaten the fragile ecosystem of the region.
4. She felt the need to threaten action if her demands were not met soon.
5. The announcement of layoffs seemed to threaten the morale of the entire team.
