

THYMUS

Meaning: Thymus: a lymphoid organ located in the chest that is essential for the maturation of T-cells and the development of the immune system, particularly during childhood.

1. The thymus is a crucial organ for the development of the immune system in early life.
2. As children grow, the thymus gradually shrinks and is replaced by fatty tissue.
3. Scientists are studying the role of the thymus in immune responses to better understand autoimmune diseases.
