Meaning: TIC: a habitual, involuntary muscular contraction or movement, often occurring in response to stress or anxiety.

1. The child nervously tapped her foot, a common tic that often surfaced during stressful situations.
2. His facial tic became more pronounced when he was anxious about speaking in public.
3. Many people with Tourette syndrome experience involuntary tics that can be both motor and vocal.
4. After years of therapy, she learned how to manage her nervous tic in social settings.
