

TITULARITY

Meaning: Titularity refers to the state or condition of holding a title or position, often without corresponding authority or responsibility.

1. The concept of titularity often raises questions about the responsibilities that come with a title.
2. In many organizations, titularity does not always correlate with actual power or influence.
3. Her titularity as the department head was recognized by her peers, even if she didn't exercise much authority.
4. The debate over titularity in the arts highlights the difference between creative ownership and mere recognition.
5. He held the titularity of the chair in philosophy, a position steeped in tradition but lacking true decision-making power.
