

# TOISE

*Meaning: Toise: a measuring instrument, typically a rod or stick, used for determining height or length.*

1. The artist used a toise to ensure the proportions of her sculpture were accurate.
2. After measuring the room with a toise, the architect decided on the perfect layout for the furniture.
3. In ancient times, builders relied on a toise to maintain uniformity in their constructions.
4. The toise, a traditional unit of measurement, was essential for the craftsmen of the era.
5. He pulled out the toise to verify the length of the wooden beams before starting the project.
