

TOMPION

Meaning: Tompion: a plug or stopper used to seal the openings of a cannon or other equipment to prevent moisture and debris from entering.

1. The sailor carefully fitted the tompion into the ship's cannon to protect it from moisture.
2. During the maintenance check, the technician removed the tompion from the hydraulic system.
3. In the workshop, the carpenter used a wooden tompion to seal the end of a pipe.
4. Before storing the vintage wine bottle, he ensured a tompion was securely placed in the neck.
5. The museum exhibit showcased a historic cannon, complete with its original tompion.
