Meaning: Top-hamper (verb): to hinder or obstruct progress or effectiveness, often by imposing excessive restrictions or limitations.

1. The company's decision to top-hamper their budget led to unexpected financial difficulties.
2. To top-hamper his efforts, the strict regulations made it nearly impossible to launch the new product.
3. She felt that the excessive requirements would only top-hamper the creativity of the team.
4. In an attempt to top-hamper the project, several stakeholders introduced conflicting priorities.
