

TOUCHBACK

Meaning: Touchback: a situation in football where the ball is kicked into the end zone and not returned, resulting in the offensive team starting their possession at the 20-yard line.

1. The game resumed with a touchback after the kickoff sailed over the end zone.
2. During the match, the referee signaled a touchback, allowing the offense to start at their own 20-yard line.
3. After the ball was kicked into the end zone and remained there, the result was a touchback.
