Meaning: Traducent: allowing light to pass through but diffusing it so that objects beyond are not clearly visible; semi-transparent.

1. The traducent glass allowed soft sunlight to filter into the room without harsh glare.
2. Her skin had a traducent quality, revealing the faintest hint of the veins underneath.
3. The artist used traducent layers of paint to create a depth that captivated the viewer.
4. In the dim light, the traducent fabric of her dress shimmered like a delicate mist.
5. The traducent water in the pool was so clear that the bottom was visible even from the surface.
