

TRANSHIP

Meaning: Tranship (verb): to transfer cargo from one vessel to another during transportation, often at a port, before reaching its final destination.

1. The cargo will tranship at the next port before heading to its final destination.
2. To optimize shipping costs, the company decided to tranship goods via a more efficient route.
3. Transshipping containers can sometimes lead to delays if not managed properly.
4. The logistics team is responsible for ensuring that all items are correctly transhipped.
5. In the shipping industry, transshipment is a common practice to facilitate international trade.

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
