

TRANSLITERATE

Meaning: To transliterate means to convert text from one writing system into another by representing the original sounds with corresponding characters, without translating the meaning.

1. The scholar decided to transliterate the ancient script to make it accessible to modern readers.
2. In order to preserve the original sounds, the linguist chose to transliterate the foreign names instead of translating them.
3. Transliterating complex characters can often lead to misunderstandings if the phonetics are not carefully considered.
4. The software was designed to transliterate various alphabets, allowing users to input text in their native language.
5. Students in the language class practiced how to transliterate phrases from their textbooks into the Latin alphabet.
