Meaning: Transpose: to change the position or order of elements, such as altering the key of a musical piece or rearranging variables in an equation.

1. The musician decided to transpose the song to a higher key for easier vocal performance.
2. When solving the equation, she needed to transpose the variables to isolate x on one side.
3. The artist chose to transpose the colors in her painting to create a more vibrant effect.
4. To improve the workflow, the team had to transpose the tasks among the members for better efficiency.
5. In mathematics, you can transpose a matrix by swapping its rows and columns.
