Meaning: TREASONABLE: Adjective describing actions or intentions that betray one's allegiance to their government or sovereign, typically involving acts of treason.

1. The defendant was charged with treasonable acts against the government.
2. His treasonable intentions were revealed during the investigation.
3. The council debated whether the leaked documents constituted treasonable conduct.
4. She faced severe consequences for her treasonable allegiance to the rival faction.
5. Historically, treasonable offenses have been punished with the utmost severity.
