Meaning: Tributarily: in a manner that contributes or flows into something larger or more significant.

1. The river flows tributarily into the larger lake, contributing to its ecosystem.
2. She acknowledged her debt to the community, saying it had shaped her tributarily throughout her life.
3. The smaller streams fed the main river tributarily, creating a complex network of waterways.
4. In the meeting, he discussed how the project would benefit the community tributarily over the coming years.
5. The artist's work was influenced tributarily by the styles of her predecessors, blending old and new techniques.
