

TRICHINOUS

Meaning: Trichinous refers to a condition related to or caused by the presence of Trichinella larvae, typically resulting from the consumption of undercooked meat, particularly pork, and associated with health risks.

1. The trichinous condition, caused by consuming undercooked pork, can lead to severe health complications.
2. Veterinarians often educate farmers about the risks of trichinous infections in livestock.
3. Symptoms of a trichinous infection may not appear until weeks after ingestion of contaminated meat.
4. Research into trichinous parasites has advanced significantly in recent years, improving food safety measures.
5. Trichinous larvae can invade muscle tissue, making diagnosis challenging without proper testing.
