

TRICOCCOUS

Meaning: Tricocous refers to seeds or fruits that have a three-angled or three-cornered shape.

1. The tricocous seeds of the plant exhibit a unique three-angled shape that aids in their dispersal.
2. Botanists often study tricocous fruits to understand the evolutionary adaptations of different species.
3. In her research, she discovered that the tricocous structure of the seeds helps them cling to animal fur.
4. The trichomes on the surface of tricocous seeds give them a distinctive texture that is fascinating to observe.
