

TRIFORIUM

Meaning: Triforium: a shallow gallery or passageway in a church, typically located above the nave and below the clerestory, often adorned with decorative elements.

1. The triforium in the cathedral features intricate stonework that draws the eye upwards.
2. Many Gothic cathedrals include a triforium, often serving as a decorative gallery above the nave.
3. The architect designed the triforium to enhance the acoustics of the church during musical performances.
