

TRIGEMINAL

Meaning: Trigeminal refers to the fifth cranial nerve that is responsible for sensation in the face and motor functions related to chewing.

1. The trigeminal nerve is responsible for sensation in the face and motor functions such as biting and chewing.
2. Patients with trigeminal neuralgia often describe severe, stabbing pain in the facial region.
