Meaning: A trigraph is a group of three letters that together represent a single phonetic sound in a word.

1. A trigraph is a combination of three letters that represent a single sound in a word.
2. In phonetics, a trigraph can help illustrate complex vowel sounds that can't be captured by a simple digraph.
3. The English language includes several trigraphs, such as "tch" in "watch" and "igh" in "high."
4. Students often struggle with spelling words that contain trigraphs due to their unusual letter combinations.
5. Teachers frequently emphasize the importance of recognizing trigraphs when helping children learn to read.
