

# TROPHIC

*Meaning: Trophic refers to the relationships and levels of energy transfer among organisms in an ecosystem, particularly in relation to their feeding and nutritional roles.*

1. Trophic levels in an ecosystem help scientists understand energy flow among organisms.
2. The study of trophic dynamics reveals how species interact within their habitats.
3. Predators often occupy higher trophic levels, while herbivores are typically found at lower ones.
4. Changes in trophic relationships can significantly impact biodiversity and ecosystem stability.
5. Trophic cascades occur when the addition or removal of a species disrupts the food web.
