

# TUBEROSITY

*Meaning: TUBEROSITY: A rounded prominence or swelling on a bone or plant root that serves as a site for muscle attachment or nutrient storage, respectively.*

1. The doctor explained that the tuberosity on the patient's bone indicated a site of muscle attachment.
2. In botany, tuberosity refers to the swollen part of a plant's root that stores nutrients.
