Meaning: TUMULOSE: characterized by or relating to a landscape featuring mounds or hills, often associated with burial sites.

1. A tumulose landscape often captures the imagination with its rolling, mounded hills.
2. The archaeologists discovered a tumulose site that held ancient burial mounds.
3. Many indigenous cultures constructed tumulose structures as part of their ceremonial practices.
4. The natural erosion over time has shaped the tumulose formations into unique patterns.
5. Visitors to the national park were fascinated by the tumulose terrain that dotted the hiking trails.
