

TURTLEHEAD

Meaning: Turtlehead is a common name for a flowering plant (genus Chelone) known for its distinctive, turtle-shaped blooms and attraction of pollinators, as well as a term used to describe a turtle's head visible above the water or hiding among rocks.

1. The turtlehead plant blooms in late summer, attracting a variety of pollinators to the garden.
2. During our hike, we spotted a turtlehead peeking out from behind a rock near the pond.
3. The unique shape of the turtlehead flower resembles a turtle emerging from its shell.
4. In folklore, the turtlehead was often associated with longevity and wisdom among Native American tribes.
5. After researching aquatic plants, I decided to include turtlehead in my water garden for its striking appearance.

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
