

TUT-MOUTHED

Meaning: 'Tut-mouthed' refers to expressing disapproval or annoyance through a clicking sound made with the tongue against the roof of the mouth, often accompanied by a facial gesture of discontent.

2. She rolled her eyes and tut-mouthed at the careless mistakes in the report.
3. His tut-mouthed expression made it clear that he was unimpressed with the proposal.
4. In response to her friend's decision, she couldn't help but tut-mouth in disbelief.
5. The teacher tut-mouthed at the students who were chatting instead of paying attention.
