

ULMIN

Meaning: ULMIN: A term referring to the ulna, one of the two long bones in the forearm, located on the side opposite the thumb.

1. The ulnar nerve runs alongside the ulmin and can sometimes become compressed.
2. During the examination, the doctor noted unusual swelling around the ulmin.
3. Athletes often experience discomfort in their ulmin due to repetitive stress injuries.
