Meaning: Ultimatum: a final demand or statement of terms, the rejection of which may lead to a breakdown in negotiations or relationships.

3. The ultimatum gave the team 48 hours to meet the project's deadline or face consequences.
4. He felt that the ultimatum was unfair and would lead to further conflict.
